Ash Wednesday is March 2. The season of Lent is observed from Ash Wednesday to the beginning of Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. Catholics aged 18 – 59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting is one full meal or two smaller meals. Catholics 14 and older are obliged to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays during Lent. (Deacon Roger)
