They are still living in the forest and mountains, far away from civilized society. The Government development work is not done. They are systematically displaced or deprived of their land. They have no proper house, hospitals, food, water, roads etc. Our members work for their faith formation, education for the poor children, orphanages, old-aged homes, drug rehabilitation centers, job-oriented centers etc. The fund is also used for the formation of future priests. Therefore, our congregation needs the fund for these above development work among the indigenous people.
